

KC METRO CITIZENS OPPOSE WAR ON IRAQ!

Because we love freedom, we take to the streets, the media, the halls of Congress, the White House, the United Nations and the voting booths our opposition to a military attack on Iraq.

Because we condemn terrorism, we refuse to encourage it by exacerbating tensions in an already unstable Middle East. "I told the American government that if you strike at the Iraqi people because of one or two individuals and leave the Palestinian issue [unsolved], not a single [Arab] ruler will be able to curb the [rising of] popular sentiments" Egyptian President Hosni Mubarak (Associated Press, Aug. 27, 2002)

Because we are threatened by corporate crime, unemployment, indecent health care, growing poverty, an AIDS crisis, a crumbling environment, and the erosion of civil rights, we refuse to be distracted by an unnecessary and unjustified call to war. *Most terrorism experts agree that links between Hussein's government and al Qaeda are murky at best, and Iraq has not been implicated in the September 11 attacks.* (San Francisco Chronicle, Oct. 12, 2002)

Because we are protective of the U.S., we reject provoking an attack by Iraq by invading it. According to a letter delivered to Congress, CIA Director George Tenet reported that at an October 2nd closed hearing a Senior Intelligence Witness testified, "the probability of him (Saddam) initiating an attack in the foreseeable future, given the conditions we understand now, the likelihood I think would be low." Tenet warned, "Should Saddam conclude that a U.S.-led attack could no longer be deterred, he probably would become much less constrained in adopting terrorist actions." (New York Times, Oct. 9, 2002)

Because we fear weapons of massive destruction, we call upon all nations, including the United States, to begin peaceful global multilateral disarmament.

Because we know the facts, we advocate reliance on U.N. weapons inspections in Iraq as a sensible and peaceful alternative to war. "The return of inspectors would provide an immediate security benefit. Even if the inspectors encounter renewed Iraqi obstruction and concealment, their very presence in the country would disrupt potential weapons development efforts." Because we oppose Saddam Hussein's rule, we believe he should be made accountable to his people. *Twelve years of ineffective economic sanctions against Iraq have destroyed a society, contributed to the death of hundreds of thousands, and made the U.S. a scapegoat for a disaster that is not all its own doing. Dropping economic sanctions could force Saddam to face responsibility, and could be linked to Iraq's compliance with weapons inspections.*

Because we support the liberation of the Iraqi people, we refuse to kill them. We believe sanction-free, war-free, well-nourished, healthy, educated and self-sufficient people can determine their own destiny.

Because we are proud, we resist the shame of becoming an international outlaw by launching a preemptive strike, a violation of the Charter of the United Nations.

Because we are people of conscience, we know that the unilateral preemptive strike proposed by the Bush administration, and unsupported by the vast majority of other nations and citizens, is foolish and arrogant. It would set a dangerous precedent, justifying similar strikes by other nations upon one another.

Because we grieve the events of September 11, we condemn the further loss of human lives and humanity that violence inevitably brings. "We have learned, first hand, the human cost of terrorism and war... We would not wish this on any other family, anywhere in the world. We must remember that lives will be lost--both American service people and civilians, as well as Iraqi civilians--in a military campaign, which could fuel the fires of future terrorist attacks. We must exhaust all other possibilities before embarking on this course of action." Ryan Amundson, a Hartville, Missouri resident who lost his brother Craig at the Pentagon on September 11, 2001. Because we love our children, we refuse to send them to shed their blood for oil. *Oil is always a driving factor behind U.S. military intervention and violent conflicts in the Persian Gulf region. Development of environmentally sound energy alternatives and transportation policies is in everyone's interest.*

Because peace is possible, we reject the Bush administration's \$150-million marketing campaign to sell us on the necessity of war, as well as the \$200 billion price tag of actually going to war. *The Congressional Budget Office estimates that a heavy ground war with three months of combat, heavy ground troops and a five-year occupation force could total more than \$272 billion, and that occupation costs alone might run as high as \$4 billion per month.* (New York Times, Sept. 27, 2002; www.msnbc.com, Oct. 21, 2002) *What if we demanded that our government spend even a fraction of that amount to develop peaceful alternatives?*
