**MSNBC - McCLATCHY IOWA DEMOCRATIC CAUCUS POLL RESULTS**

400 likely Democratic caucus participants were interviewed by telephone December 26-28, 2007 by Mason-Dixon Polling & Research, Inc. of Washington, D.C. The margin for error is plus or minus 5%. Interview quotas were assigned by county based on delegate allocation, not voter registration or voter turn-out.
